RESOLUTION R2026-XXX

RESOLUTION DETERMINING MOZINGO CONSTRUCTION, INCORPORATED (MOZINGO) TO BE THE LOWEST, RESPONSIVE, AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER FOR THE ZONE 36/39 STORM DRAIN IMPROVEMENTS PHASE 1 OUTFALL PROJECT (DISTRICT 1: LOCATED NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF WOODWARD AVENUE AND APLICELLA COURT AND APPROXIMATELY 3,000 FEET WEST OF WOODWARD AVENUE) (CIP 20004); APPROVING A BUDGET APPROPRIATION OF \$3,789,774 IN THE PUBLIC FACILITIES IMPLEMENTATION PLAN DRAINAGE FUND (FUND 580) TO CIP 20004; AWARDED THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO MOZINGO IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,964,001; APPROVING A PROJECT CONTINGENCY OF \$795,999 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO TAKE ALL APPROPRIATE ACTIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSE AND INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Zone 36/39 Storm Drain Improvements Phase 1 Outfall (CIP 20004)(Project) is designed to convey stormwater flows south of State Route 120 to a new surface water discharge into the San Joaquin River at the west end of the City of Manteca (City) limit; and

WHEREAS, the Project includes construction of a new outfall structure on the San Joaquin River at the former Oakwood Lake Water District corporation yard and installation of a forty-eight-inch (48") force main that will carry stormwater runoff along the toe of the Reclamation District 17 (RD 17) levee from the future pump station near Woodward Avenue and Applicella Court to the new outfall structure; and

WHEREAS, the outfall structure on the San Joaquin River portion of the Project has a narrow window of construction in accordance with the environmental permitting that limits in-water construction to between July 15th and November 1st; and

WHEREAS, a future phase will include the pump station required to pump the 66" gravity line storm water thru the 48" force main to the outfall structure/terminal discharge point; and

WHEREAS, On January 21, 2020, the City Council authorized the expenditure and execution of an Agreement for Professional Services with Dewberry (C2020-10) for the Project's Engineering, Environmental, and Permitting Services; and

WHEREAS, On March 17, 2026, the City Council approved the Project Plans, Specifications and Estimate and authorized a Call for Bids; and

WHEREAS, the Project was advertised for bid and posted on the City's website, a mandatory job walk was held on April 1, 2026, and bids were opened on April 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the Base Bid, bidders were required to include costs for four (4) Additive Alternate items including Backfilling Pond 3 (A-1), Emergency Overflow Connection (A-2), Lift Station 3 Emergency Discharge (A-3), and Emergency Overflow Storage Tank (A-4); and

WHEREAS, staff reviewed the bids and determined Mozingo Construction, Inc. to be the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder, with a bid amount of \$7,964,001, including all four Additive Alternate items; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at the public meetings of the City Council identified herein, including any supporting reports by City Staff, and any information provided during public meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Manteca, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct and establish the factual basis for the City Council's adoption of this Resolution.
2. The City Council hereby determines Mozingo to be the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder for the Zone 36/39 Storm Drain Improvements Phase 1 Outfall Project (CIP 20004).
3. The City Council hereby awards the construction contract to Mozingo in the amount of \$7,964,001, inclusive of all four (4) Additive Alternate bid items.
4. The City Council hereby approves a budget appropriation of \$3,789,774 in the Public Facilities Implementation Plan Drainage Fund (Fund 580) to CIP 20004.
5. The City Council hereby approves a project contingency of \$795,999, for a total contract not-to-exceed limit of \$8,760,000.
6. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or designee to execute the construction contract and approve contract change orders up to the total Project budget, apply for permits, apply for State and Federal grants, solicit

project funding support, complete and execute all associated documents, and take all appropriate actions necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of the resolution.

7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
