RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANTECA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING REVISION OF THE 2025-26 CDBG AND HOME FUNDS

WHEREAS, each year the City publishes a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnership (HOME) funds; and

WHEREAS, the funding amount in the NOFA are an approximate and are based on last year's allocation amount, and

WHEREAS, funding recommendations, based on applications received in response to the NOFA, are presented Council based on the approximate amount, and

WHEREAS, when Housing and Urban Development Department (HUD) releases their revised funding allocation the City must revise its original approved allocation amounts, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at the public meetings of the City Council identified herein, including any supporting reports by City Staff, and any information provided during public meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Manteca, as follows:

- 1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct, and establish the factual basis for the City Council's adoption of this Resolution.
- 2. Decrease the Fiscal Year 2025-26 CDBG Grant Funding allocation from \$426,003 to \$420,013.
- 3. Decrease the following CDBG funding allocation for a total of \$5,990 (FUND 140):
 - a. Decrease from \$9,025 to \$8,845.30 for San Joaquin Fair Housing Foundation San Joaquin Fair Housing.
 - b. Decrease from \$3,000 to \$2,820.30 for Emergency Food Bank Mobile Farmers Market.
 - c. Decrease from \$7,000 to \$6,820.30 for San Joaquin County Human Services Agency (Meals on Wheels).
 - d. Decrease from \$13,000 to \$12,820.30 for Give Every Child A Chance Before and After School Mentor/Tutor Program.

- e. Decrease from \$9,000 to \$8,820.30 for San Joaquin County Human Services Agency Rental Assistance.
- f. Decrease from \$302,102.55 to \$297,011.05 for City of Manteca Manteca Navigation Center.
- 4. Decrease the Fiscal Year 2025-26 HOME funding allocation from \$116,052 to \$111,278.
- 5. Decrease HOME funding allocation to the Manteca Navigation Center/Affordable Housing project by \$4,774 for a total appropriation of \$111,278 to the Manteca Navigation Center/Affordable Housing Project (Fund 130).
- 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
