I don't have experience in park planning or design, but I do believe my experience in project management provides insight for this opportunity. A requirement should be to engage effectively with community organizations and communicate innovative ideas to the City Council. My idea of a great neighborhood park is one that is used by the majority of families in Manteca that creates unity and togetherness across the city. I have seen that most of the parks are scattered and some are rarely used (especially in the North side of Manteca). It would be great to ask the neighbors what they wish to see in their community through a needs assessment. One observation I've made so far is that although Manteca has the Tidewater Bikeway, the Northern side of Manteca does not have an official running track for people to go for a walk or run only. Another project that would be great to have is for Manteca to have a recreation and aquatic center that includes an indoor pool for people to use throughout the year, an art room, a community lounge for senior citizens, game rooms, a gymnasium, a fitness center, and a social hall with a kitchen. To maintain this recreation center, it would be great to open job opportunities for Manteca residents and require residents to pay a membership price or daily admissions price.
