RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANTECA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO CONTRACT SERVICES (C2023-55) WITH MTM TRANSIT LLC TO EXTEND THE TERM FOR ONE (1) ADDITIONAL YEAR AND INCREASING THE NOT-TO-EXCEED COMPENSATION BY \$2,938,685.42 FOR A TOTAL NOT-TO-EXCEED CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$9,958,315.89; AUTHORIZING A BUDGET APPROPRIATION OF \$100,000 IN THE FEDERAL TRANSIT MANAGEMENT FUND (FUND 610); AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE AMENDMENT AND TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2023 the City Council approved and awarded a transit operations contract with MTM Transit LLC to operate the Manteca Transit System; and

WHEREAS, the City entered into a Professional Services Agreement with MTM Transit LLC on May, 2, 2023 to provide transit operations services in Fiscal Years 2023-24 through 2025-26; and

WHEREAS, the agreement with MTM Transit LLC will expire on June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the Agreement for one additional year as allowed under section 4 of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, due to an increase in service hours in ADA Paratransit there is a need to increase compensation of \$100,000 to the base term; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at the public meetings of the City Council identified herein, including any supporting reports by City Staff, and any information provided during public meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Manteca, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct, and establish the factual basis for the City Council's adoption of this Resolution.

2. The City Council hereby approves Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement with MTM Transit LLC and increases the compensation to the base term.
3. The City Council authorizes a budget appropriation in the amount of \$100,000 in the Federal Transit Management Fund (Fund 610).
4. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or designee to take all necessary actions to sign and implement the agreement.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
