RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANTECA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM LIST OF PROJECTS ELIGIBLE FOR SENATE BILL 1 FUNDING: AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT APPROVED LIST OF PROJECTS TO THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR FUNDING APPORTIONMENT. COMPLETE, AND EXECUTE ALL ASSOCIATED DOCUMENTS, AND TAKE ALL APPROPRIATE ACTIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSE AND INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 ("SB1"), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017, to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of the City of Manteca ("CITY") are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the CITY must adopt by resolution, a list of projects eligible to receive funding from the State Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB1. Which must include: a description and location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the CITY is expected to receive an estimated \$2.2 million in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2025-26 from SB1; and

WHEREAS, this is the ninth year in which the CITY is receiving SB1 funding and will enable the CITY to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB1; and

WHEREAS, the CITY has undergone a public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the CITY used a Pavement Management System along with public feedback, to develop the SB1 project eligibility list to ensure revenues are being used on

the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB1 will help the CITY maintain and rehabilitate local streets/roads, and add active transportation infrastructure throughout the CITY this year and similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the CITY's streets and roads are in an "at-risk" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "good" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials, and practices will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Manteca, as follows:

- 1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct, and establish the factual basis for the City Council's adoption of this Resolution.
- The City Council hereby adopts a list of projects and the attached SB1 Project Location documents, Attachment 2, for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 funded by SB1
 The Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017.
- 3. The City Council hereby approves the following CIP SB1 projects to receive Road Repair and Accountability Act funding and as shown on the SB1 Project Location attachment:

- 5. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or designee to complete, and execute all associated documents, and take all appropriate actions necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of the resolution.
- 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
