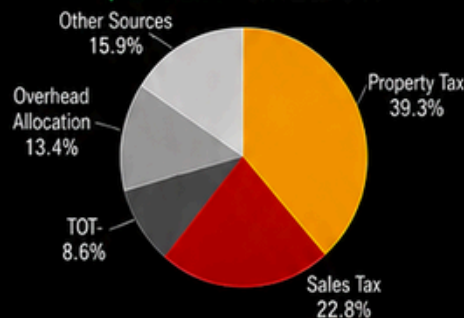

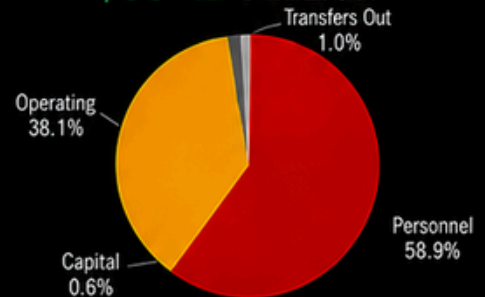

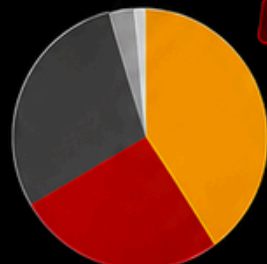

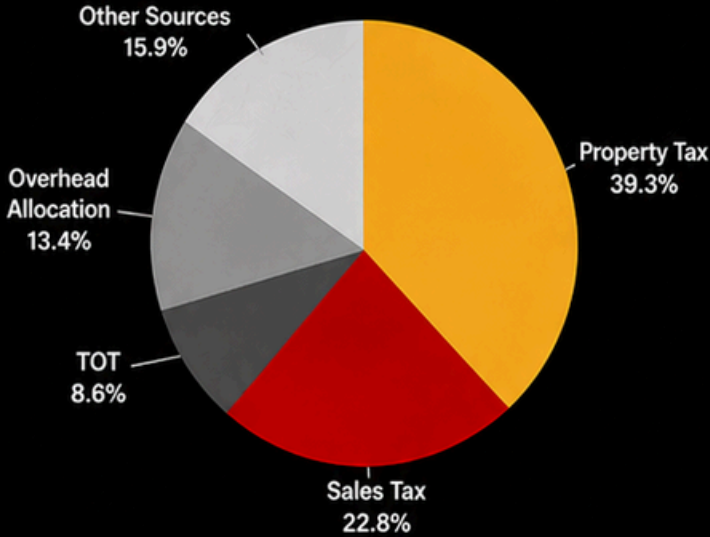

GENERAL FUND BUDGET



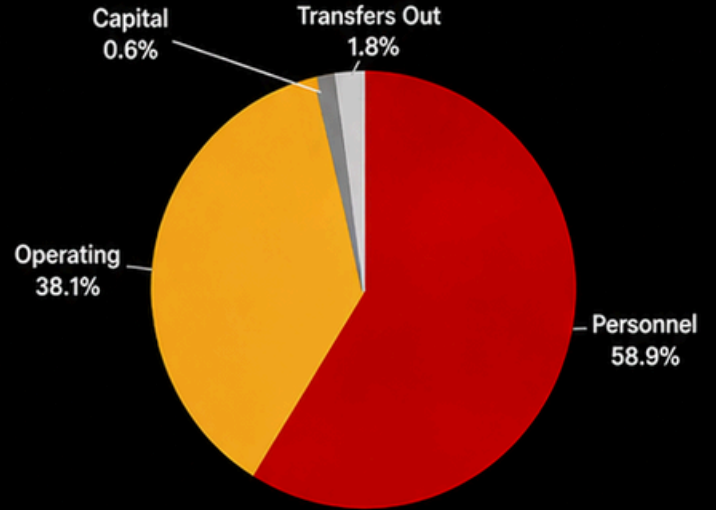
GENERAL FUND REVENUES

\$87 MILLION

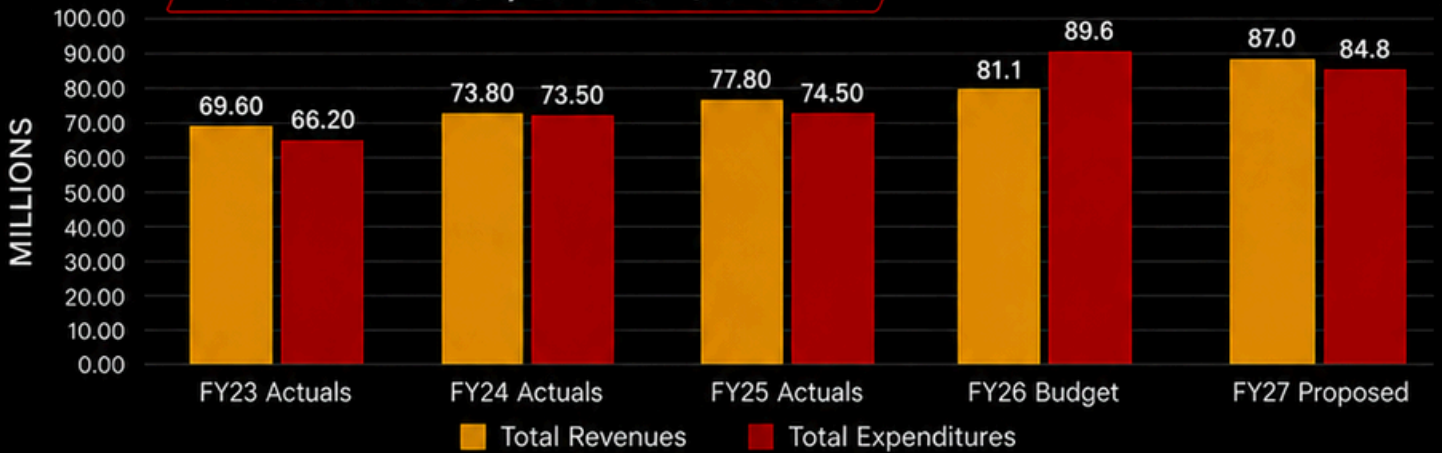


GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES
