RESOLUTION R2026-XX

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANTECA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING 180-DAY WAIT PERIOD EXCEPTION GOVERNMENT CODE SECTIONS 7522.56 & 21224

WHEREAS, in compliance with Government (Gov.) Code section 7522.56, the City of Manteca City Council must provide CalPERS this certification resolution when hiring a retiree before 180 days has passed since their retirement date; and

WHEREAS, Eric Oliveri (CALPERS ID: On File in Human Resources) retired from South San Joaquin County Fire Authority in the position of Fire Captain, effective November 17, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Gov. Code section 7522.56 requires post-retirement employment commence no earlier than 180 days after the retirement date, which is May 16, 2026 without this certification resolution; and

WHEREAS, Gov. Code section 7522.56 provides that this exception to the 180-day wait period shall not apply if the retiree accepts any retirement-related incentive; and

WHEREAS, the City of Manteca City Council, City of Manteca and Eric Oliveri certify that Mr. Oliveri has not and will not receive a Golden Handshake or any other retirement-related incentive; and

WHEREAS, the City of Manteca City Council hereby appoints Eric Oliveri as an extra help retired annuitant to perform the duties of Deputy Fire Chief for the City of Manteca under Gov. Code section 21224, effective January 7, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the entire employment agreement between Eric Oliveri and the City of Manteca has been reviewed by this body and is attached herein; and

WHEREAS, no matters, issues, terms or conditions related to this employment and appointment have been or will be placed on a consent calendar; and

WHEREAS, the employment shall be limited to 960 hours per fiscal year for all CalPERS employers; and

WHEREAS, the compensation paid to retirees cannot be less than the minimum nor exceed the maximum monthly base salary paid to other employees performing comparable duties, divided by 173.33 to equal the hourly rate; and

WHEREAS, the maximum base salary for this position is \$17,916.67 per month and the hourly equivalent is \$103.36 per hour, and the minimum base salary for this position is \$14,593.24 per month and the hourly equivalent is \$84.19 per hour; and

WHEREAS, the hourly rate to be paid to Eric Oliveri will be \$84.19 per hour; and

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WHEREAS, Eric Oliveri has not and will not receive any other benefit, incentive, compensation in lieu of benefit or other form of compensation in addition to this hourly pay rate; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Manteca hereby certifies the nature of the appointment of Eric Oliveri as described herein and detailed in the attached employment agreement and that this appointment is necessary to fill the critically needed extra help assignment to assist with the programming, testing, installation and implementation of the Fire Department communications system.
