

**RESOLUTION R2026-XX**

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANTECA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE STORM DRAIN ZONE 36/39 IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT PHASE 1 OUTFALL CONSTRUCTION, APPROVING THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT NOTICE OF EXEMPTION DETERMINATION, AUTHORIZING A CALL FOR BIDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO TAKE ALL APPROPRIATE ACTIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSE AND INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION (EXEMPT FROM CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. CODE REGS. § 15301(C).)

WHEREAS, the City identified the Storm Drain Zone 36/39 Improvements Project (CIP 20004) in the Storm Drain Master Plan to provide terminal drainage for southwest Manteca; and

WHEREAS, the Project includes a sixty-six-inch (66") gravity storm drain line within Woodward Avenue to property owned by Reclamation District 17 (RD 17) on Aplicella Court; then from the RD 17 property, a pump station and forty-eight-inch (48") force main will carry the storm runoff along the toe of the levee to the former Oakwood Lake Water District corporation yard and over the levy to an outfall structure on the San Joaquin River; and

WHEREAS, due to the size of the project, it is being split into phases with this Phase 1 Outfall Construction (Project) to include the outfall structure and the 48" force main portions of the overall project, and the completion of the 66" line and the pump station to be future phases; and

WHEREAS, the outfall structure on the San Joaquin River has a narrow window of construction in accordance to the environmental permitting that would preclude in-water construction on the outfall from November 1st through July 31<sup>st</sup>; and

WHEREAS in order to expedite the construction schedule, maximize the narrow construction timeframe for in-water work, and optimize use of available funds, staff has prepared the Plans, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted (R2021-182) the Project's Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); and

WHEREAS, Plans, Specifications, and Estimates (PS&E) have been completed for the Project and are available for review in the Engineering Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at the public meetings of the City Council identified herein, including any supporting reports by City Staff, and any information provided during public meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Manteca, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct, and establishes the factual basis for the City Council’s adoption of this Resolution.
2. The City Council hereby approves Plans and Specifications for the Storm Drain Zone 36/39 Improvements Project Phase 1 Outfall Construction.
3. The City Council hereby authorizes a Call for Bids.

The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or designee to apply for permits, apply for State and Federal grants, solicit project-funding support, complete and execute all associated documents, and take all appropriate actions necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
