- 2. The City Council does hereby accept the DHS FEMA Grant Programs Directorate FY 2024 SAFER Grant for nine firefighters, up to \$2,692,300.
- 3. The City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all grant-related documents and take all necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of the resolution.
