National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week April 12 - 18, 2026

Whereas, across the nation in times of intense personal crisis and community-wide disasters, the first access point for those seeking emergency services is 9-1-1; and

Whereas, local and county public safety communications centers that receive these calls have emerged as the first and single point of contact for persons seeking immediate relief during an emergency as well as those seeking to report suspicious behaviors and unusual incidents; and

Whereas, while enduring shift work and frequent emergencies, City of Manteca Police Communications Dispatchers continue to perform their duties in a dedicated, diligent, and loyal manner; and

Whereas, City of Manteca Police Communications Dispatchers provide a critical but seldom visible linkage between the citizen and police, fire, and emergency medical providers; and

Whereas, City of Manteca Police Communications Dispatchers consistently perform outstanding public service that deserves praise and recognition; and
