National Police Week

May 11-16, 2026

Whereas, In 1962, President Kennedy proclaimed May 15 as National Peace Officers Memorial Day and the calendar week in which May 15 falls, as National Police Week; and

Whereas, the members of the law enforcement agency of the City of Manteca play an important role in safeguarding the rights and freedoms of the citizens of our community; and
