

RESOLUTION R2024-XXX

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANTECA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution R2024-76, Calling and Giving Notice of the holding of a General Municipal Election on November 8, 2022, for the purpose of the election of two members of City Council (District 1 & 2 Councilmembers); and

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution R2024-77, requesting the County Registrar of Voters render specified services for the conduct of said Election; and

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution R2024-123, approving an ordinance enacting a 0.75% (or 0.75 cents per dollar) transactions and use tax to be administered for 20 years by the California department of tax and fee administration, and ordering the submittal of said ordinance to the voters at the November 5, 2024, Election; and

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Manteca, California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2024, the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Joaquin provided the results of the November 5, 2024, City of Manteca General Municipal Election, made a part hereof as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, THE City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at the public meetings of the City Council identified herein, including any supporting reports by City Staff, and any information provided during public meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Manteca, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct, and establish the factual basis for the City Council's adoption of this Resolution. By this Resolution, the City Council

herby declares the results of the 2024 General Municipal Election pursuant to California Elections Code Section 10263.

2. That the names of persons voted for at the election for Member of City Council and Measure are as follows:

3. The City Council does declare and determine that: Charlie Halford was elected as District 1 Councilmember of the City Council for the full term of four years; Regina Lackey was elected as District 2 Councilmember of the City Council for the full term of four years; and the passage of Measure Q.
4. The City Clerk of the City of Manteca shall enter on the records of the City Council a Statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) The names of the persons voted for; (3) For what office each person was voted for; and (4) The total number of votes given to each person.
5. That the City Clerk of the City of Manteca shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.
6. That the City Clerk of the City of Manteca is directed to provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Office of the County of San Joaquin Registrar of Voters.
7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
