RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANTECA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$35,000 FROM THE NATIONAL FITNESS CAMPAIGN TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF AN OUTDOOR FITNESS COURT AT WOODWARD COMMUNITY PARK; AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM TO ESTABLISH A NEW PROJECT; AUTHORIZE A \$500,000 BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN THE PARK ACQUISITION AND IMPROVEMENT FEES FUND (FUND 500); AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Manteca applied to participate in the National Fitness Campaign (NFC) 2026 initiative to install and activate outdoor fitness courts in communities nationwide; and

WHEREAS, the City has been selected by the National Fitness Campaign to receive a \$35,000 award to support the development of a publicly accessible outdoor fitness court at Woodward Community Park; and

WHEREAS, the National Fitness Campaign operates as a public-private partnership, and the award is applied as a discount toward the purchase of fitness equipment rather than provided as direct funding to the City; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will expand access to outdoor fitness infrastructure and promote health and wellness for residents of all ages and abilities; and

WHEREAS, implementation of the project requires the establishment of a new Capital Improvement Project for the Woodward Park Fitness Court Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated project cost is \$500,000 and will be funded by the Park Acquisition and Improvement Fees Fund (Fund 500); and

WHEREAS, sufficient fund balance is available in Fund 500 to support the proposed budget appropriation, and there is no impact to the General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Manteca, as follows:

ATTACHMENT 1

1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct, and establish the factual basis for the City Council's adoption of this Resolution.
2. The City Council hereby accepts participation in the National Fitness Campaign for the installation of an Outdoor Fitness Court at Woodward Community Park, acknowledging that the \$35,000 award is applied as a discount toward equipment purchase and does not result in revenue to the City.
3. The City Council hereby Amends the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Capital Improvement Program to establish the Woodward Park Fitness Court Improvement Project.
4. The City Council hereby authorizes a budget appropriation in the amount of \$500,000 in the Park Acquisition and Improvement Fees Fund (Fund 500) for the Woodward Park Fitness Court Improvement Project.
5. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or designee to execute all documents and take all actions necessary to implement the project and carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution.
6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
