National First Responders Day

October 28, 2025

Exercise, individuals, both professionals and volunteers, including law enforcement personnel, emergency operators and dispatchers, firefighters, emergency medical technicians (EMTs), public works professionals, hospital and medical facility staff, search and rescue personnel, and many others, serve the public as first responders in the event of an emergency; and

Exercise, at a moment's notice, first responders are quick to respond to dangerous situations that threaten our cities, counties and state. First responders provide services that are foundational to a safe, healthy, and vibrant community. Their work spans a wide range of critical functions that directly support the daily lives; and

Exercise, first responders embody the enduring commitment to protect and preserve the safety of our communities; they work overtime, are away from their families, and in some cases, put their health and their lives at risk. First responders are vital members of our communities, protecting our neighbors and loved ones from existing threats and remaining vigilant for new threats that may emerge.; and

Exercise, the families of first responders also make significant sacrifices to support their loved ones' service; these family members live with the reality that their spouse, sibling, parent, or loved one may not return home from the job, and they deserve our appreciation and respect for bearing this burden; and
