RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANTECA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, RATIFYING THE CITY MANAGER'S ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF THE HOMELESS HOUSING, ASSISTANCE AND PREVENTION (HHAP) PROGRAM – ROUND 5 GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNTS OF \$270,791.84 FOR THE UNSHELTERED EMERGENCY CENTER AND \$29,643.66 FOR STREET OUTREACH; APPROVING REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE APPROPRIATIONS OF \$300,436 IN THE HUD GRANTS FUND (FUND 141); AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL ASSOCIATED AND NECESSARY DOCUMENTS RELATED TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE GRANT

WHEREAS, the County of San Joaquin and the San Joaquin Continuum of Care (CoC) announced the availability of funding under Round 5 of the State of California's Homeless Housing, Assistance, and Prevention (HHAP) Program to support eligible activities addressing homelessness; and

WHEREAS, in March 2024, the San Joaquin Continuum of Care Board of Directors adopted local funding priorities for HHAP Round 5 following a community-wide engagement and consensus-building process, identifying eligible project categories including permanent housing, interim housing, street outreach, homelessness prevention, service coordination, and systems support activities to strengthen regional homelessness response efforts; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Joaquin and the San Joaquin Continuum of Care jointly released a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for HHAP Round 5 funds in November 2025; and

WHEREAS, through the local HHAP Round 5 funding process, the City of Manteca was awarded \$270,791.84 for Interim Housing operations and services at the Unsheltered Emergency Center and \$29,643.66 for Street Outreach activities; and

WHEREAS, San Joaquin County requested expedited execution of the HHAP Round 5 agreements to allow timely presentation to the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors in February 2026 and facilitate prompt distribution of grant funds; and

WHEREAS, these reimbursable grant funds will support the City's efforts to serve individuals experiencing homelessness and enhance service delivery at the emergency center located at 555 Industrial Park Drive; and

WHEREAS, due to the limited timeframe associated with grant execution and funding deadlines, the City Manager executed the HHAP Round 5 Subrecipient Agreements prior to City Council consideration to avoid jeopardizing the awarded funding; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends ratification of the City Manager's acceptance and execution of the HHAP Round 5 grant agreements and approval of related budget appropriations into HUD Grants (Fund 141).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Manteca, as follows:

1. Ratifies the City Manager's acceptance and execution of the Homeless Housing, Assistance and Prevention (HHAP) Program – Round 5 Subrecipient Agreements for Interim Housing in the amount of \$270,791.84 and Street Outreach in the amount of \$29,643.66.
2. The City Council approves revenue and expenditure appropriations of \$300,436 in the HUD Grants Fund (Fund 141).
3. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to execute all associated and necessary documents related to the administration of the HHAP Round 5 grant funding.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
