


Background / History Family Entertainment Zone & ENAs

- Dec. 2012 City Enters into an ENA with McWhinney Real Estate Services
- Jan. 2013 City Enters into an ENA with ANF Development, LLC
- Jan. 2014 City Enters into a \$100,000 Reimbursement Agreement with Manteca Development Group for financial assistance
- Aug. 2016 City Enters into an Amended ENA with Manteca Development Group to include 13.73 acres on the east side of Milo Candini
- Dec. 2016 City Enters into an ENA with Manteca Development Group to provide, (1) Development Schedule, (2) Market Analysis, and (3) Project Description and Use Plan

City Projects Affecting the FEZ

- Public Works Solar Project 15.5 acre set aside
- Feb. 15, 2019 Council adopts resolution determining Borrego Solar Systems, Inc. to be the Best Value for the WQCF Alt. Energy Project
- Parks and Recreation Recreational Facilities
- Parks & Rec. is currently studying two locations in the FEZ for Recreational Facilities

- 1. Continue working on an ENA based on Project Information presented for the FEZ this evening by Manteca Development Group?
- 2. What is the appropriate Term for the ENA?
 One Year + 120 Calendar Days
 Three Years
- 3. Does the City Council want to commit to amending the Master Plan and the Environmental Document when the Project is approved (conceptual approval by Council)?
- 4. Does the City Council want to commit to preceding with negotiations to enter into a DA with MDG when the Project is approved (conceptual approval by Council)?
