ORDINANCE 02021-XX

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANTECA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADDING 1.08.050 GENERAL ELECTIONS – CAMPAIGN LIMITS.

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2021, during the Regular City Council Meeting, City Council discussed and provided direction on the state changes to campaign contribution limits in response to Assembly Bill 571; and

WHEREAS, City Council, unanimously, voted to follow the state contribution limits. The current state limit on contributions from an individual per calendar year is \$4,900; and

WHEREAS, this amount is subject to change by the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) in January of odd-numbered years, to reflect increases or decreases in the Consumer Price Index, rounded to the nearest \$100; and

WHEREAS, under AB 571, the FPPC will have expanded administration and provided enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at the public meeting of the City Council identified herein, including any supporting reports by City Staff, and any information provided during public meetings.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANTECA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> Amendment. Manteca Municipal Code section 1.08.050 – General Elections – Campaign Limits is hereby amended to read as follows:

The City of Manteca follows the state campaign contribution limit, set by the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC). The FPPC also is the enforcing agency for campaign contribution limits.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any section, sub-section, subdivision, paragraph, clause or phrase in this Ordinance, or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections or portions of this Ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed each section, sub-section, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days following adoption.
